Protection of personal data

The Data Protection Act 14th March 2021

has taken note of the law on the protection of personal data and privacy of users accessing the Site.

The protection of your personal data is an essential and relational element. This relationship is based on a principle of transparency aimed at respecting the privacy of each individual in accordance with the regulations in force in Europe, in particular for the application of the French Data Protection Act and the General Data Protection Regulation (RGPD), the "Regulations".

In this respect, the user is informed that, in the context of the use of the Site, some of his personal data may be collected and processed by each browser, including Google, in accordance with the applicable legal and regulatory provisions, in particular the current version of the law for confidence in the digital economy.

The aforementioned law defines "personal data" as any information relating to a natural person who is identified or can be identified, directly or indirectly, by reference to one or more elements that are specific to him or her.

Collection of data

The site rejeton.com undertakes to collect personal data only for necessary and precise purposes, The user's personal data is currently collected via the site's newsletter registration form, there is currently no collection for donations, and includes the following data

Postal address (for donors only)

We only keep the data for as long as is necessary for the above purposes and for a maximum of twelve months if there is no exchange, or to enable us to meet our legal obligations.

Destinations, reminder

The nominative information is strictly intended for the use of the site rejeton.com and only the administrator(s) of the Site is then able to access, manage and process the information.

Rejeton.com undertakes not to sell, rent, transfer or give access to third parties to the user's personal data without the user's prior consent, unless compelled to do so by a legal requirement (judgement, order, exercise of the rights of defence, etc.).

In accordance with legal requirements, Rejeton.com will only keep the user's personal data for the minimum and maximum retention periods provided for by the applicable legislation. Postal address (only if future donors)

Security of personal data given?

The security of access to the rejection.com site is subordinated to the LWS host on the one hand, and, on the other hand, the listing will be on a secure flow and stored in computer encryption. Respect for the security and protection of your data is imposed on the site manager and, failing that, on all of the collaborators as well as on our hosting service provider, LWS.

Access to rights management

You may request at any time access to your personal data, its rectification, deletion and the limitation of one or more particular processing operations of data concerning you, under the conditions provided for by the Regulations.

You also have the right to modify or withdraw, at any time, the consents you have given us for the processing of your personal data. Your personal data may be retained or deleted after your death in accordance with the Regulations.
